



SUPPLEMENTAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR CONTRACTS COVERED BY THE FEDERAL ACQUISITION REGULATION (FAR) AND DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE FAR SUPPLEMENT (DFARS)

Bascom Hunter Technologies, Inc. (“Buyer”) has awarded or seeks to award a contract to Seller in support of a U.S. government contract for which Buyer is subject to certain clauses of FAR and DFARS and for which applicable clauses shall be flowed down to any lower-tier contract.

Buyer and Seller agree that the below-identified clauses are hereby incorporated into any purchase order or other contract between Buyer and Seller deriving from Buyer’s government contract, and Seller further agrees to flow down to its subcontractors all applicable FAR and DFARS clauses and any other applicable law to ensure that Buyer and Seller comply with the requirements of Buyer’s government contract.

Seller further understands and agrees that the requirements below are developed in accordance with Buyer’s prime contract and are not modified by Buyer for each individual Seller or statement of work. Seller assumes the responsibility for providing to any government agency, Buyer, or Buyer’s customer, evidence of compliance with the requirements herein or that such requirements are not applicable to the extent satisfactory to the requesting party.

For each of the below-listed clauses, Buyer and Seller agree that in each instance the term “Government or Contracting Officer” shall be replaced by “Prime Contractor”; and the term “contractor or prime contractor” shall be replaced by “subcontractor.”

FLOWDOWNS – NONCOMMERCIAL PRODUCTS AND SERVICES:

The following clauses are incorporated into the contract with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text and are applicable to all subcontracts for noncommercial products and services (as defined by FAR Subpart 2.101).
